



## Coaches and volunteers Code of Conduct

This is the abbreviated code of conduct and is not intended to replace the Chester Hockey club full code of conduct but contains the principals that we expect you present in all of your duties as a representative of the club.

- To consider the wellbeing and safety of all participants before the development of performance.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with all participants based on mutual respect and trust
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to age, ability and experience of the players.
- Promote the positive aspect of hockey as a sport e.g. fair play, healthy lifestyle and team work
- Display consistent high standards of behaviour and appearance
- Hold appropriate valid qualifications and Insurance for all coaching activities
- Never exert undue influence over players to obtain personal benefit or reward
- Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibited substances
- Encourage players to value their performance not just the result
- Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
